## ABOUT SUSSEX COMMUNITY NHS FOUNDATION TRUST

We are the main provider of NHS community health and care services across West Sussex, Brighton & Hove and the High Weald, Lewes and Havens area of East Sussex, covering a population of around 1.3 million.

As the largest community health and care provider in Sussex, our vision is to provide excellent care at the heart of the community.

## WHAT WE PROVIDE

Our expert teams provide essential medical, nursing and therapeutic care to over 9,000 adults, children and families every day and we employ around 5,500 people.

From our health visitors looking after new born babies, to our community practitioners caring for people nearing the end of their life, we look after some of the most vulnerable people in our communities.

# WHAT ARE FOUNDATION TRUSTS AND HOW ARE THEY DIFFERENT?

As a Foundation Trust we are still part of the NHS but have a greater freedom to plan ahead and develop services needed by local people.

Foundation Trusts have control over the money they receive, meaning all the money coming in, including any savings we make, go into improving services. But the real difference is that we are directly accountable to the people who use our services.

# WHO ARE OUR MEMBERS AND WHAT DO THEY DO?

Our members are people who live in West Sussex, Brighton & Hove and High Weald, Lewes and Havens, who have been a patient or service user, or have an interest in what we do. Members must be aged 12 years or over.

As a member, you decide what you want to do and how much you want to be involved. You do not have to attend meetings unless you want to. Here are some of the ways you might want to get involved:

- Tell us where we should reinvest any surpluses that we make to improve patient care.
- Tell us what is good and what is not so good about the care you have received from us.
- Vote for your local Governor to represent your views.

# WHO ARE OUR GOVERNORS AND WHAT DO THEY DO?

As a Foundation Trust we have a Council of Governors which have been elected by our members. There are three types of Governors:

- Public Elected Governors
- Staff Elected Governors
- Appointed Governors

The Governors have a responsibility to represent the views of our members and to hold our Board of Directors to account.
