

FAQs - relevant to your role as a Vaccine Steward

We hope they are helpful

1. Will I be offered the Vaccine as a Volunteer

We are very much hoping to be able to offer the Covid-19 vaccine to volunteers but currently do not have a time scale for this.

2. Will I be able to use SCFT as a reference if I volunteer as a vaccine Steward?

Yes, we will be more than happy to provide a reference if you volunteer for us. Volunteering can be a very good pathway to employment.

3. Will I be safe?

The area where you will volunteer will have been risk assessed and one of the team will discuss any risks with you and what we have put in place to reduce these risks.

4. Will I wear PPE?

PPE for vaccination sites has been nationally instructed. Anyone in front of house roles will be required to wear a face mask, which will be supplied, and adhere to hand hygiene.

5. Will I be paid travel expenses?

Yes we will be able to pay your travel expenses in lieu, please keep receipts.

6. Is there a maximum on my travel?

We have to have a cut off for claiming travel which currently is 15 miles each way. If this is an issue please speak to us.

7. Is there free parking for volunteers?

Unfortunately not, but please keep receipts which we will be very happy to reimburse.

8. Do I have to wear uniform?

We are very much hoping that our new volunteer uniform will be available which will be a High Visibility Volunteer Jacket.

9. Is there Tea and Coffee Available?

We cannot confirm this at this stage but would encourage you to bring a bottle of water / snacks.



10. Can I do two shifts back to back?

Yes this will be your choice. But please tell us in advance

11. Can I continue to volunteer with SCFT after the Vaccine Programme?

Yes defiantly, we would very much welcome you

12. How long will the Vaccine programme be?

We envisage the programme to run for many months

13. Can I change my shifts at any time?

Due to the size of the programme we would very much encourage you to stick to your committed shift if at all possible. Of course there will be the occasional time you will not be able to make it, which we understand.

14. How early should I arrive for my shift?

Please arrive 5/10 minutes before your shift, we are hoping to be able to signpost you to a sign in process

15. Do I need internet access and Zoom to apply?

Unfortunately, due to the urgency of this role we can only accept volunteers who have internet access.
